PART 1 GENERAL

PROJECT

- A. Project Name: CITY OF FLOWOOD MS LIBRARY ROOF RENOVATIONS.
- B. Owner's Name: CITY OF FLOWOOD.
- C. Architect's Name: Wier Boerner Allin Architecture.
- D. Project Description: THIS PROJECT CONSISTS OF THE REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT OF THE ENTIRE EXISTING METAL PANEL ROOF SYSTEM, REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT OF ALL METAL WALL PANELS SURROUNDING THE CLERESTORY OF THE BUILDING, AND INSTALLATION OF NEW DRAINAGE PANEL AND WEATHER BARRIER AT CLERESTORY WALLS AND ALL ROOF PLANES. .

2. CONTRACT DESCRIPTION

- A. Contract Type: A single prime contract based on a Stipulated Price as described in Document 00.5000 Contracting Forms and Supplements.
- B. The scope of work of the prime contract is identified in this section, the Project Specifications and on the Drawings.

3. OWNER OCCUPANCY

- A. Owner intends to continue to occupy all portions of the existing building during the entire construction period.
- B. Cooperate with Owner to minimize conflict and to facilitate Owner's operations.
- C. Schedule the Work to accommodate Owner occupancy.

4. CONTRACTOR USE OF SITE AND PREMISES

- A. Construction Operations: Limited to areas noted on Drawings. Do not disturb portions of the project site beyond areas in which the Work is indicated.
- B. Arrange use of site and premises to allow:
 - 1. Minimize space and time requirements for storage of materials and equipment on-site.
- C. Provide access to and from site as required by law and by Owner:
 - 1. Emergency Building Exits During Construction: Keep all exits required by code open during construction period; provide temporary exit signs if exit routes are temporarily altered.
 - 2. Do not obstruct roadways, sidewalks, or other public ways without permit.
 - 3. Keep driveways, loading areas, and entrances clear and available to the Owner at all times. Schedule deliveries to minimze use of driveways and entrances.
- D. Existing building spaces may not be used for storage.
- E. Time Restrictions:
 - 1. Limit conduct of especially noisy exterior work to the hours of 7:00am-7:00pm.
 - 2. Weekend Early and After hours Work shall be subject to the approal of the Owner and regulation by authorities having jurisdiction..
- F. Utility Outages and Shutdown:
 - 1. Do not disrupt or shut down life safety systems, including but not limited to fire sprinklers and fire alarm system, without 7 days notice to Owner and authorities having jurisdiction.
 - 2. Limit shutdown of utility services to 2 hours at a time, arranged at least 48 hours in advance with Owner.
 - 3. Prevent accidental disruption of utility services to other facilities.

5. WORK SEQUENCE

- A. Coordinate construction schedule and operations with Owner.
- B. Coordinate construction schedule and operations with Architect.

- C. Contract construction duration shall be 6 months upon the issue of the Notice to Proceed. If the project is not substantially complete on the date set forth in the Contract Documents, the Contractor shall be liable for and will pay the Owner the sum of \$500 per day in Liquidated Damages.
- D. Interior lighting installation duration shall be limited to 3 weeks where the facilities will be closed to the public. The 3 week window shall commence once all submitals have been approved and all materials have been acquired and an anticipated installation start date has been coordinated/approved by the Owner and Architect. If the lighting installation is not substantially complete by the end of the 3 week period, the Contractor shall be liable for and will pay the Owner the sum of \$1,000 per day in Liquidated Damages. Corrective work as noted in the Certificate of Substantial Completion can be completed outside of the 3 week period without damages.

3. WHERE MATERIALS ARE APPLIED TO, OR ARE IN DIRECT CONTACT WITH WORK INSTALLED BY ANOTHER SUBCONTRACTOR, COMMENCEMENT OF WORK IMPLIES ACCEPTANCE OF THE SUBSTRATE AS SUITABLE FOR THE APPLICATION INTENDED.

4. ISOLATE DISSIMILAR METALS TO PREVENT GALVANIC CORROSION.

5. PARTITION TYPES AND FIRE RESISTIVE RATINGS INDICATED ON A WALL ARE TO BE CONTINUOUS FOR THE LENGTH AND HEIGHT OF A PARTITION.

6. OPENINGS IN RATED WALL, FLOOR, CEILING AND ROOF ASSEMBLIES SHALL BE SEALED WITH PENETRATION SEALANT SYSTEMS MEETING OR EXCEEDING THE REQUIRED FIRE RESISTIVE RATINGS.

7. MAINTAIN THE FIRE RATING OF CONSTRUCTION AROUND CABINETS, PANELS, AND BOXES RECESSED IN FIRE RATED WALL, FLOOR, AND CEILING ASSEMBLIES.

8. PROVIDE CONTINUOUS PERIMETER FIRE SAFING BETWEEN FLOORS AND COORDINATE THE INSTALLATION WITH THE EXTERIOR WALL. FIRE RATING OF SAFING SHALL MATCH FIRE RATING OF FLOOR

9. DO NOT SCALE THE DRAWINGS.


10. FIELD MEASURE AND CONFIRM DIMENSIONS FOR OWNER PROVIDED EQUIPMENT AND FURNISHINGS.




